Three houses, a rocky wall Monte | Valle di Muggio | CH

A main street runs through the village as the main vein dividing Monte in two areas: here three family houses draw a new limit and conclude the constellation of facades on it. Enveloped around the trees, the building searches for a relation with the nude rocky wall behind.

The volume is fragmented, adapting its shape to the different situations: a silent facade with small openings on the main road, while on the courtyard the living spaces relate to each other.

The organic movement of the spaces provides various possibilities for a more spontaneous human behaviour.
