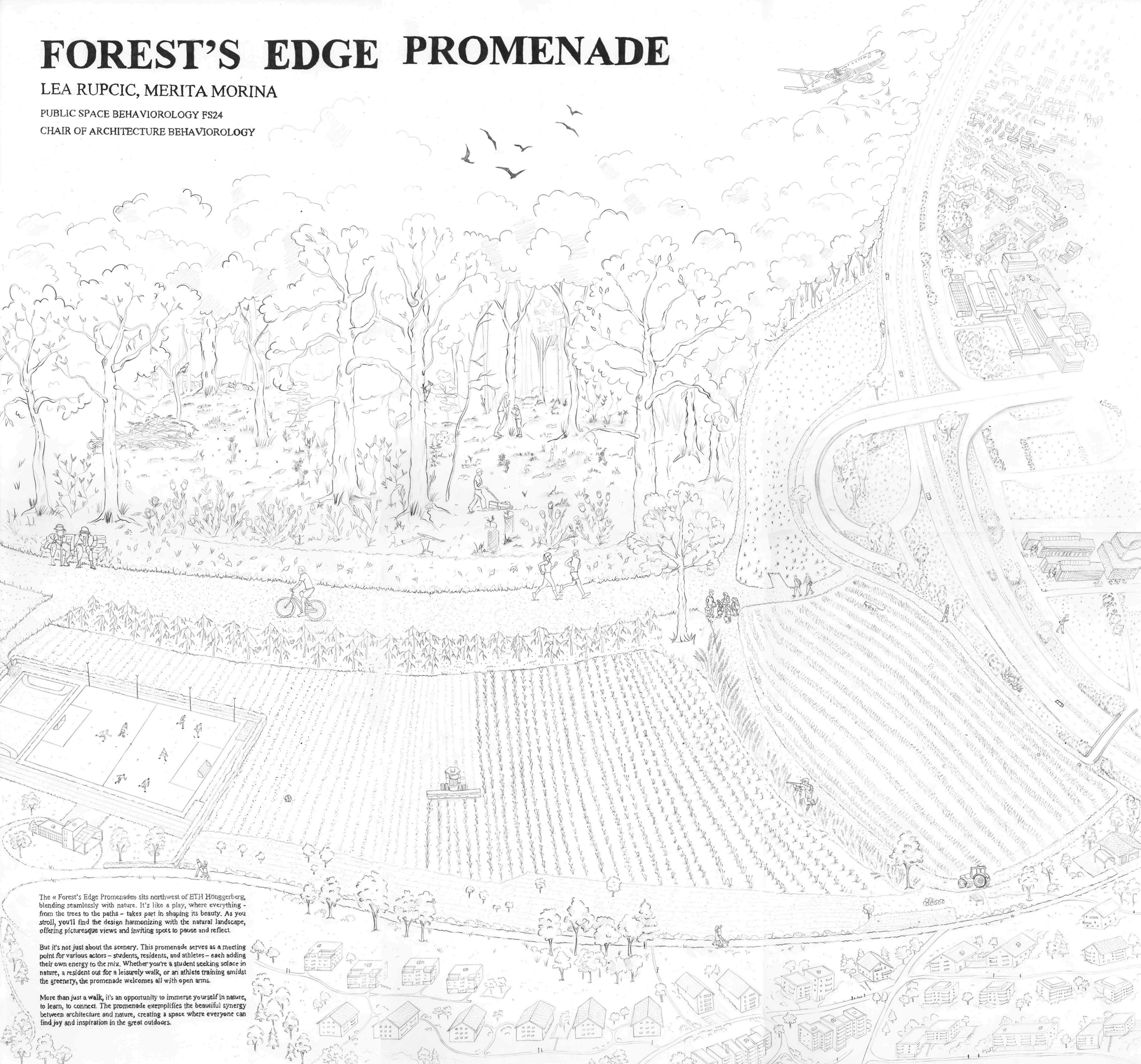


FOREST'S EDGE PROMENADE
