Crossing the Holderbach by a wooden bridge you're entering the storm damage area, which is located at the edge of the forest. This area is characterized by a storm from 2021, which destroyed most of the vegetation. Because of that and the upcoming infestation by bark beetles it was necessary to intervene by cutting the damaged trees.

The forestry work differs between the Arboretum, where new trees are planted as a scientific trial for new species and the adjacent section along the pathway, which is left to its natural development. Thereby this unsheltered space attracts new informal uses by visitors, such as creating a fireplace or taking the opportunity to walk along the Holderbach.
